A new clinical research study to collect information on the use of an investigational drug called Atuliflapon in adults who have moderate-to-severe asthma that is not controlled with current treatment alone.

- Are 18 to 80 years old.
- Have been diagnosed with asthma for more than a year.
- Are experiencing asthma symptoms such as wheezing and breathlessness and have had at least one asthma flare-up for which steroids were required in the last year.
- Are currently being treated with daily inhaled asthma medications and have been for at least 3 months.

There are other criteria that you will need to meet to qualify, which the study team will discuss with you.
